EXPLANATORY NOTES GREAT PORTLAND ESTATES plc ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING 2018



- (1) Every holder has the right to appoint some other person(s) of their choice, who need not be a shareholder, as his proxy to exercise all or any of his rights to attend, speak and vote on their behalf at the meeting. If you wish to appoint a person other than the Chairman, please insert the name of your chosen proxy holder in the space provided. If the proxy is being appointed in relation to less than your full voting entitlement, please enter in the box next to the proxy holder's name the number of shares in relation to which they are authorised to act as your proxy. If left blank, your proxy will be deemed to be authorised in respect of your full voting entitlement (or if this proxy form has been issued in respect of a designated account).
- (2) This form of proxy must be executed under the hand of the holder or his duly authorised attorney or in the case of a corporation, it must be executed under its common seal or under the hand of some officer or attorney duly authorised in that behalf. A member of the Company entitled to attend and vote at this meeting may appoint one or more proxies to attend and vote in his stead. A proxy need not also be a member of the Company.
- (3) To appoint more than one proxy, you may photocopy the form. Please indicate in the box next to the proxy holder's name (see reverse) the number of shares in relation to which they are authorised to act as your proxy (which, in aggregate, should not exceed the number of shares held by you). Please also indicate by ticking the box provided if the proxy instruction is one of multiple instructions being given.

- (4) Lodgement of the form of proxy will not preclude a shareholder from attending the meeting and voting in person. A member must inform the Registrars of the Company in writing of any termination of the authority of a proxy.
- (5) This form of proxy must be completed, signed and deposited with the Registrars of the Company, Link Asset Services, PXS 1, 34 Beckenham Road, Beckenham, Kent BR3 4ZF, not later than 48 hours (excluding any UK non-working days) before the meeting or adjourned meeting at which the proxy proposes to vote together with any authority (or a notarially certified copy of such authority) under which it is signed. CREST members should refer to the Notice of meeting on pages 188 and 189 of the Annual Report 2018 in relation to the submission of a proxy appointed through CREST. You may also appoint a proxy online by following the instructions for the electronic appointment of a proxy at www.signalshares.com
- (6) In the case of joint holders, the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holders, and for this purpose seniority will be determined by the order in which the names stand in the register of members.
- (7) Any alterations made in this form should be initialled.

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
